## New catch for Prevas

**Lerøy Aurora AS and Laksefjord AS order Infor EAM maintenance system from Prevas.**

Lerøy Aurora AS is a part of Lerøy Seafood Group ASA ([www.leroy.no](http://www.leroy.no)), a leading exporter of fish and shellfish from Norway and the world's second-largest producer of Atlantic salmon.

Lerøy Aurora AS, headquartered in Tromsø, is self-sufficient in smolt (young salmon) thanks to its fully owned subsidiary Laksefjord AS, and the company has its own salmon processing and packaging plant. The plant has a daily capacity of approximately 330,000 kg, working in two shifts.

Laksefjord AS is responsible for smolt production in Lerøy's northern Norwegian salmon operations and produces about 7 million smolts each year. An increase in production to 11 million smolts is planned for 2014 and expansion has already begun.

Both of these companies have now chosen Infor EAM from Prevas as their new maintenance system and are initiating the implementation project during August.

"We previously looked at several different maintenance systems," says Geir-Sigvart Isaksen, lead engineer at Lerøy Aurora and employed at the company since 2007.

"Infor EAM has the user friendliness and functionality we're looking for," Geir-Sigvart Isaksen adds. "Prevas could also provide us with a number of references in the fish breeding industry.
